# PLEASE DISSEMINATE THE BULLETIN TO AS MANY MEMBERS AS POSSIBLE TO KEEP THEM INFORMED

- 1. <u>2021 CONVENTION</u>: Our 2021 Convention will be in Houston, Texas sponsored by our Lone Star Chapter. They are already working out the planning and we will be posting the fliers and registration in the near future.
- 2. <u>ALL AMERICAN WEEK (AAW) 2021</u>: We have begun planning of our AAW 2021 event with more information available soon. We will be using Moon Hall as our main venue for 2021 and will begin registration and hotel reservations in January 2021, with hopes that by January we will have more information on the event for 2021.
- 3. <u>VETERAN'S DAY 2020 EVENT:</u> The 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Division Association will be conducting the 2020 Veteran's Day Event in Washington, DC to continue our recognition of the Fallen Heroes of the 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Division by laying wreaths in Arlington National Cemetery, and at the WW II, Korean War, Vietnam War, Desert Storm, and General Eisenhower National War Memorials. Due to the restrictions of COVID-19, we will not know for sure if we will be allowed to lay wreaths within Arlington National Cemetery until two weeks before the event. If we are unable to lay wreaths inside of the Cemetery, we will lay a wreath at the entrance to the Cemetery and lay wreaths at the above listed War Memorials in Washington, DC. Also, due to COVID-19, the Association will be providing numerous protocols to ensure the safety of our Members attending the event. We will also be reducing the wreath laying to only 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Division Unit Markers to lessen the contact time, and due to our inability to drive to some of the locations due to construction closing some of the roads within the Cemetery. The event will be from 9-11 November 2020, with Wreath laying operations on 10 and 11 November 2020. #### 5. CHANGES IN MEMBERSHIP DUES APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS: The

BOD has approved the following changes to the 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Division Association Membership dues:

- **a.** There will no longer be a maintenance fee on the All-American Membership. The All-American Membership will be \$350 only, with no additional fees after 5 years, as had previously been dictated. This will also apply to anyone who obtained an All-American Membership since the fee was enacted. Plainly stated, no one will be charged a maintenance fee for their All-American Membership no matter when they obtained their Membership.
- **b.** The Membership fees for Active Duty Members currently assigned to the 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Division:
  - \$82 for E-1 to E-4.
  - \$150 for E-5 to E-7 and W-1 & W-2 and O-1 to O-3.
  - \$350 for all others: E-8 and E-9, W-3 and above, and O-4 and above.
  - The first year of an Annual Membership for Active Duty currently assigned to the 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Division will remain **FREE.** All following Annual Active Duty Membership dues will remain at \$35.

- 12. <u>CURRENT PROJECTS OF THE ASSOCIATION</u>: This is a list of some of the Projects the Association has approved for working on in 2020:
  - **a.** <u>Support for Families of 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Division KIAs, and WIAs:</u> Provide assistance to the 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Division Association Wounded Warrior Fund through direct response to needs of Families immediately following the loss or injury of an 82<sup>nd</sup> Trooper.
  - b. <u>Support for deployed Troopers of the 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Division:</u> Currently supporting redeployed Troopers placed in quarantine at Ft Bragg by arranging liquid refreshments to the Troops. Our Association stands ready to provide support to our Deployed Troopers as they protect our Nation. The more donations we receive, the more we can do to support our Troopers while they are deployed. Help us to show these Troopers our gratitude for their sacrifices.
  - c. <u>Holiday Troop Support 2020</u>: This year will be our 5<sup>th</sup> Annual "Holiday Troop Support" and we will again provide over 1000 meals to young Troopers and their Families over the Thanksgiving and Holiday Season to insure the Families of young 82<sup>nd</sup> Troopers have bountiful Holiday meals over the Thanksgiving and Christmas Season (will be accomplished through corporate, Chapter and individual donations).



d. <u>Increasing Support for Dependent Children of 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Division Fallen Heroes:</u> The 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Division Association is currently looking into projects to increase our support of the Dependent Children of our 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Division Fallen Heroes.
